The structured questions was based on several no of multiple choice questions which were answered by our participants. Statistical tool utilized are pie chart.


Software used MS- Excel was used to organize and analyses raw data collected from survey. It was very resourceful for making the graphical representation of the collected information's.




Informer-


Family members(Adult)-

350 responses




Number of children (Family)-

350 responses




Family earning member-


Types of work-


Monthly income-

350 responses




Family condition-


School going children-
